The Office of Geographic Information Services, newly created by the 87th General Assembly, is responsible for providing information technology transfer and educational services and data to all users of GeoStor to enables specific county level projects to become more integrated within GeoStor. The office also carries out the duties and authority of the Arkansas Land Board, coordinates the data development to support the creation of a digital flood map, and updates and maintains the Arkansas Spatial Data Infrastructure (ASDI) - a public resource that provides storage and easy access to essential statewide geographically linked information such as maps, boundaries, aerial photography, facilities, and natural resources.
