TO AMEND AMENDMENT 51 OF THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION; TO AMEND 7-5-406 TO ALLOW FOR USE OF THE FEDERAL WRITE-IN ABSENTEE BALLOT WITHOUT PRIOR REGISTRATION.

TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM WEIGHT ALLOWED ON THE FRONT OR STEERING AXLE OF A VEHICLE.

TO GIVE COUNTY OFFICIALS ADMINISTRATIVE RIGHTS TO COUNTY ELECTRONIC INFORMATION AND RECORDS.
