- ✓ \*Arkansas requires that all novice teachers going through the nontraditional licensure program to have a mentor for two years; the mentor is paid \$1200 per year and the teacher is provided \$800 per year for professional development and materials.
- ✓ \*Additional costs are the responsibility of the Arkansas Department of Education, thus no immediate effect on State Treasury.
