HCR1002 LENDERMAN RECOGNIZING NATIONAL FFA WEEK.

REGULAR BILLS

HB1365 H. WILKINS TO REQUIRE BACKSEAT PASSENGERS OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO COMPLY WITH THE CURRENT MANDATORY SEATBELT LAW AND CLARIFY APPLICABLE PENALTIES.

HB1142 B. WILKINS TO SPECIFY THAT INTEREST ON DECEASED ARKANSAS TEACHER RETIREMENT SYSTEM MEMBER'S ACCUMULATED CONTRIBUTIONS WHEN NO SURVIVOR ANNUITY IS PAYABLE CEASES AFTER FIRST FULL FISCAL YEAR FOLLOWING MEMBER'S DEATH; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

HB1147 CARNINE TO LIMIT THE NUMBER OF YEARS THAT THE ARKANSAS TEACHER RETIREMENT SYSTEM, BENEFIT PARTICIPANTS, OR EMPLOYERS MAY LOOK BACK WHEN ADJUSTING OBLIGATIONS BETWEEN THE SYSTEM; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

HB1158 BRANSCUM TO ALLOW ADDITIONAL TIME FOR MEMBERS OF THE ARKANSAS PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO SELECT CONTRIBUTORY SERVICE.

HB1143 LENDERMAN CONCERNING CERTAIN BENEFITS UNDER THE ARKANSAS TEACHER RETIREMENT SYSTEM; TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD TO PROMULGATE RULES CONCERNING ANNUITY OPTIONS; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.
