## I) AGENCY SUMMARY \& REVENUE SOURCES <br> Mission

The Arkansas Court of Appeals was established by the General Assembly pursuant to the provisions of Amendment 58 to the Arkansas Constitution. The Court was established to help alleviate the tremendous caseload of the Arkansas Supreme Court, which had become virtually unmanageable by the mid-1970s. The Court of Appeals is composed of a total of twelve judges. The state is divided into four districts and three Court of Appeals Judges represent each district.
Total Biennial Budget
The total budget for the 2011-2013 is $\$ 4,147,437$ for FY2012 and $\$ 4,227,091$ for FY2013.
Funding Source
The Court of Appeals is funded by the State Central Services Fund.

- Requests $\$ 4.1$ million each year which is $\$ 10,500$ over base level to restore Capital Outlay to FY2011 authorized level.
