I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

Arkansas Board of Examiners in Counseling regulates the title and practice of Counselors and Marriage and Family Therapists in our State. The Board monitors and records the supervision of each new license until the license holder has completed the mandated three (3) years of supervised practice. The board conducts investigations into violations of Statutes, Rules and Regulations, complaints, and practice without a license. Disciplinary Hearings held before the Board are pursuant to the Arkansas Administrative Procedures Act and arranged with the counsel of the Arkansas Attorney General's Office.

TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET

The total budget request is \$273,562 in the first year and \$276,473 in the second year of the biennium.

FUNDING SOURCE

Funding is supported from fees collected from initial licensure and biannual renewal of licenses.
