# PHARMACY BOARD (283) 2011-13 BIENNIUM - Legislative Recommendation

# I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

#### MISSION

The Pharmacy Board licenses, regulates, and disciplines pharmacists, interns, pharmacist technicians and businesses engaged in the practice of pharmacy.

### TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET

The total budget for the Pharmacy Board is \$1,420,095 for the first year and \$1,449,481 the second year of the biennium.

### FUNDING SOURCE

The budget is funded by license and exam fees and penalties paid by license holders.

#### II) CHANGES/APPROPRIATIONS

The operations appropriation, funded by cash funds for \$1,370,095 the first year and \$1,399,481 the second year, has:

1. Continuation of \$56,250 in appropriation only (received from the DFA cash holding account in FY11) and request of additional \$14,000 in FY12 and \$27,195 in FY13 in operating expenses for the transition of hosting responsibilities of a licensing database, the purchase of hardware (3 desktop computers, a scanner and a color printer) and software to convert records to a digital format; increased pharmacy inspector travel, increased printing and postage costs for renewal cards and increased payments to the information network of Arkansas for criminal background checks.

#### IV) SPECIAL LANGUAGE

1. Transfer language allowing up to \$50,000 to be transferred from the Board of Pharmacy to UAMS - College of Pharmacy to provide student loans.
