I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The Commission is responsible for identifying and meeting the needs of individuals with spinal cord disabilities in Arkansas. The Commission provides a broad range of services (case management, personal care, education, resource development, etc.) to assist individuals in living the most independent life possible.

TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET

The Commission's appropriation for FY12 is \$2,839,047 and \$2,868,124 for FY13.

FUNDING SOURCE

The budget is funded by general revenues, cash funds from private donations, small grants, proceeds from educational activities, and federal funds. An increase of General Revenue funding of \$16,000 is being recommended for each year to add clients to the Long Term Attendant Care program that are currently on the waiting list for services.

II) CHANGES/APPROPRIATIONS

- Increase of \$15,000 in appropriation and general revenue funding in Grants and Aid Commitment item for the Long Term Care program.
- Increase appropriation of \$472,702 each year for the Spinal Treatment Program line item should funds become available.
- Increase in Federal appropriation of \$10,000 each year to purchase audio visual and office equipment.
- Increase of \$5,000 each year in Cash appropriation Operating Expenses to purchase office and training equipment.
- The Research & Statistics Supervisor position was deleted and an Information Technology Manager position was added with no total change in the number of authorized positions.
