I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

Parole Board is composed of seven full-time members appointed by the Governor and approved by the Senate. Board responsibilities include conducting parole hearings throughout the State, making decisions on the conditional release of inmates from correctional facilities, review all pardon and executive clemency applications and make non-binding recommendations to the Governor. The board is responsible to grant, deny, suspend, and revoke parole in accordance with legislative criteria.

TOTAL APPROPRIATION

The total budget is \$1,909,777 the first year and \$1,939,973 the second year of the biennium.

FUNDING SOURCE

The board operates from one appropriation and is funded from General Revenues through the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund.
