### I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

### MISSION

The Arkansas Wheat Promotion board was created by Act 283 of 1985. The purpose of the Board is to plan and conduct a program of research, market development and advertising to promote the wheat industry in Arkansas. The Board consists of nine members appointed by the Governor.

## TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET

The total budget of the 2011-13 Biennium is \$791,871 for each fiscal year.

# FUNDING SOURCE

The Board is funded entirely from special revenues collected from a one cent per bushel assessment on all wheat grown in Arkansas.

## II) SIGNIFICANT CHANGE LEVEL REQUESTS

• The **Operations** appropriation, funded by Special Revenues, provides a total Base Level appropriation of \$791,871 each fiscal year with no change levels.
