I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The Commission is responsible for establishing minimum standards for the selection and training of law enforcement officers in Arkansas. The Commission provides basic training for new officers and specialized training for certified police officers at the ALETA training academy near East Camden, while also providing field training classes across the state.

TOTAL APPROPRIATION

The Commission operates from two appropriations. The total budget for the operating appropriation is \$3,286, 627 and is funded from general revenues through the miscellaneous agencies fund account. The second appropriation is cash funded totaling \$500K each year and provides for special training

FUNDING SOURCE

The Commission is funded primarily from general revenues from the miscellaneous agencies fund and cash funds.

II) CHANGES/APPROPRIATIONS

Operations - increase of \$22K each year for food costs and sales tax.

Special Training - increase of \$131K each year for tuition costs and the purchase of kitchen equipment.

New Appropriation, 911 Training & Education - \$120K of appropriation and one new position, Grade C120 Training Instructor.

Discontinue the Drug Detection Training Federal Appropriation.

III) ADDITIONAL POSITIONS: ONE, Grade C120 Training Instructor
