I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES Mission

The Lieutenant Governor is one of the seven popularly elected constitutional officers. According to Section 5 of the Sixth Amendment to the Arkansas Constitution, the Lieutenant Governor shall be President of the Senate, but shall only vote in the case of a tie. Section 4 of Amendment 6 provides that "in case of the impeachment of the Governor, or his removal from office, death, inability to discharge the powers and duties of the said office, resignation or absence from the State, the powers and duties of the office, shall devolve upon the Lieutenant Governor for the residue of the term, or until the disability shall cease".

Total Appropriation

The total appropriation for fiscal year 2013 is \$379,991.

Funding Source

The budget is funded through the State Central Services Fund.
