I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The State Athletic Commission exists to protect the health, safety and welfare of the participants as well as the public when involved in combative sports. The Commission is responsible for the licensing of participants, officials, and promoters; the inspection and supervision of events; posting of bonds; and passage of regulations for both professional and amateur combative sporting events in the State. These include boxing, kickboxing, wrestling, and all forms of mixed martial art events.

TOTAL Appropriation

The total appropriation for fiscal year 2013 is \$108,079.

FUNDING SOURCE

The State Athletic Commission is funded from the annual license fees of boxers, wrestlers, managers, matchmakers, promoters, referees, physicians, timekeepers, and other persons arranging or otherwise dealing in matches and exhibitions regulated by the Commission. Pursuant to Act 1085 of 1999, the Commission collects 5% of the total gross receipts from admission charges from all matches and exhibitions.

II) SIGNIFICANT CHANGES OVER 2012:

\$12K decrease in Professional Fees - for continued website development to accommodate online licensing and an online roster of all licensees.
