I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES <u>MISSION</u> The purpose and mission of the Oil & Gas Commission is to serve the public regarding oil and gas matters, to protect the correlative rights and interests of mineral owners and to regulate oil, gas, and brine production industries to insure compliance with state and federal laws regarding the protection of the environment and waters of the State.
