I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES MISSION

The Alcoholic Beverage Control Administration Division supervises, regulates and controls the manufacture, consumption transportation, dispensing, sale and alcoholic beverages in the State of Arkansas. The Division, through the Director and with the approval of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, receives applications for and issues or refuses to issue, suspends and revokes licenses to processors, distributors, manufacturers, wholesalers, retailers and transporters of alcoholic beverages. Division also promulgates rules and regulations necessary to carry out the intents and purposes of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Acts, and conducts hearings on cancellations, suspensions or revocations of permits and on all applications for private club permits.

TOTAL APPROPRIATION

The total appropriation of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Administration Division for FY2013 is \$868,754.

FUNDING SOURCE

The appropriations for this agency are funded with 98% general revenues and 2% cash.
