Re: House Bill 1123

Dear Ms. Stone:

House Bill 1123 amends one section of Arkansas Code, namely § 24-4-521. Our analysis of the proposed changes to this section follows.

Our understanding is that most of this bill is a cleanup of existing language but that the change proposed to § 24-4-521(b)(5)(A)(iii) affects current provisions for elected public officials. The change is intended to eliminate inconsistency in benefit provisions that may have arisen as a result of current language. The intention is that both the political subdivision and the elected public officials are required to each contribute an additional 2.5% of payroll for elected public officials who first served on or after July 1, 2014 in a contributory position. This change (additional charge) better allocates the costs of the two-for-one service credit benefit provision amongst the participating employers. However, total contributions to the system would be expected to remain unchanged.
