#### Basic Change :

Rep. Linck,

This bill amends various code sections that relate to the distribution of state agency publications. Generally, the amendment requires that state agencies place agency publications on the agency website and follow guidelines in the bill for other methods of distribution. The bill exempts various publications from the requirement including: public information pamphlets, legislative bills, statutes, laws and regulations, information given to the press or pursuant to a FOIA request, information, forms, and notices necessary to comply with state tax, driver's licensing, and motor vehicle registration and titling laws, and various other publications specific to identified entities.
