Basic Change:

This bill would substantially amend and repeal portions of The Free Textbook Act of 1975, codified at Title 6, Chapter 21, Subchapter 4, which is limited to K-12 instruction. It includes the term "textbooks" in the definition of "instructional materials", and makes stylistic changes throughout accordingly. The bill requires entities that sell instruction materials in Arkansas not charge more for such materials than the lowest contracted price in another state, and such entities much charge that rate uniformly to all school districts in the state.

The Office of State Procurement is neutral on this bill.
