Bill Subtitle: TO REQUIRE HEALTH BENEFIT PLANS TO PROVIDE FOR CORRECTIVE SURGERY FOR CRANIOFACIAL ANOMALY.

Basic Change:

Representative Hawthorne

Requires health insurance to cover medically necessary craniofacial reconstructive surgery.
