Basic Change :

Senator J Key

The original bill creates a special license plate for veterans that "served in Grenada during Operation Urgent Fury." The Department must promulgate rules to administer military service and veterans special license plates. The original bill does not have an effective and, thus, takes effect 90 days after adjournment.

<u>Senate Amendment #1</u>The bill as originally written would have been effective ninety (90) days after adjournment. With Amendment 1, the effective date will be January 1, 2014 and after.

With the bill as originally written, there would have been additional programming costs to program the existing system. With Amendment 1, programming may be completed with development of the new motor vehicle system; therefore, there will be no additional programming costs.
