Bill Subtitle: REGARDING THE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATING THE UNIFORM MOTOR VEHICLE DRIVER'S LICENSE ACT.

Basic Change :

Sponsor: Senator J. Woods and Representative Neal

This bill amends the penalties for persons found guilty of the following misdemeanors:

- Unlawful Use of a License:
- Permitting an Unauthorized Person to Drive;
- Unauthorized Driving with a Restricted License;
- · Permitting a Minor to Drive; and
- Driving Without a License.

Currently, each of these violations is punishable by up to a \$500 fine or up to 90 day imprisonment, but not both. This bill authorizes a court to impose both punishments.
