# I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES Mission

The Lieutenant Governor is one of the seven elected constitutional officers. According to Section 5 of the Sixth Amendment to the Arkansas Constitution, the Lieutenant Governor shall be President of the Senate. Section 4 of Amendment 6 provides that "in case of the impeachment of the Governor, or his removal from office, death, inability to discharge the powers and duties of the said office, resignation or absence from the State, the powers and duties of the office, shall devolve upon the Lieutenant Governor for the residue of the term, or until the disability shall cease".

## Total Budget

The total budget is \$398,405 for FY2014 and FY2015.

#### Funding Source

The budget is funded through the State Central Services Fund.

Operations Appropriation-State Central Services

• Increase of \$11,068 each year over base level for restoration of Extra Help which was authorized for FY2013 but was not budgeted.
