There are five appropriations which provide spending
authority for the Treasurer's Office to distribute General,
Special, and Federal Funds to counties.
II) SIGNIFICANT CHANGES
General Revenue to Counties
• Recommended at \$22,067,295 for FY2014 and \$21,645,067
for FY2015.
 Increase in appropriation over base level of \$2.4
million for FY2014 and \$2 million for FY2015.
• Increase in General Revenue Funding of \$2 million each
year.
Special Revenue to Counties
 Recommended at \$200 million each year which is \$40
million above base level due to passage of half-cent
sales tax increase for highways.
III) POSITIONS
No positions are authorized for these appropriations.
IV) SPECIAL LANGUAGE
Distribution of Funds. Funding from Property Tax Relief
Trust Fund to counties shall not be distributed unless
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revenues of \$2 million or more to report to the House and Senate Transportation Committee on how those funds were utilized. *New Language*
