I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The Contract Licensing Board exists to preserve public health and safety in the construction industry in our state. Responsibilities include determining qualifications of applicants for contractor's licenses and authorizing the issuance of new and renewal licenses, investigating all alleged and factual violations of the Contractor's Licensing Law, the Contractor's Bond Law, and the Residential Licensing Law, as well as hold hearings and the assessment of penalties to ensure compliance.

TOTAL BUDGET

The total budget for the Contractors Licensing Board is \$2,611,849 the first year and \$2,612,825 the second year of the biennium.

FUNDING SOURCE

The Contractors Licensing Board is funded from the receipt of fees charged for examination, issuance and renewal of commercial and residential contractor's licenses and penalties associated with violations of regulations.

II) SIGNIFICANT CHANGES:

Additional \$172,343 in Regular Salaries and Personal Services Matching provide for 2 additional investigator positions, one additional licensing coordinator position, and the restoration of an administrative specialist.
