I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The Beef Council was created by Act 160 of 1983. The Council's purpose is to administer a program of beef research, promotion and market development on behalf of the Arkansas cattle industry. The Council is made up of seven members appointed by the Governor.

TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET

The total budget is \$1,100,000 each fiscal year of the biennium.

FUNDING SOURCE

The Beef Council is funded entirely through special revenues collected from an assessment of \$1 per head on all cattle sold in Arkansas.

II) SIGNIFICANT CHANGE LEVEL REQUESTS

- The **Operations** appropriation, funded by Special Revenues, provides Base Level of \$1,100,000 each fiscal year with no Change Level requests for a total appropriation of \$1,100,000 each year of the biennium.

There are no authorized regular salary positions for the Arkansas Beef Council.
