I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

The Institution is located in Arkadelphia, Arkansas and is a four year institution of higher education.

TOTAL BUDGET

The Institution's total requested appropriation is approximately \$129.6 million.

FUNDING SOURCE

The budget is funded from approximately 15% General Revenue, 2% Educational Excellence Trust Funds, with the remainder as cash funds from tuition, fees & other funds (federal at 13%).

II) APPROPRIATION/CHANGES

* State Operations - Total of approximately \$21.7 million, funded from general revenue and Educational Excellence funds, includes a total increase over FY14 of approximately \$487,000 (approximately \$442,000 in Salaries, \$5,000 in Extra Help, and \$40,000 in Operating Expense line items).

* Cash Operations - Total of approximately \$120 million, funded from tuition and fees and other funds, includes an increase over FY14 of approximately \$17.2 million (\$500,000 in the Salaries, \$400,000 in Matching, \$500,000 in Operating Expenses, \$250,000 in Professional Fees/Svcs., \$600,000 in Capital Outlay, and \$15 million in Capital Improvements line items).

III) POSITIONS

Total positions for FY2014: 711 Total positions for FY2015: 712 Increase/(Decrease): 1; added Assistant Athletic Trainer @ \$43,709.

IV) SPECIAL LANGUAGE

* Special Allowance: Authorizes special allowances of up to \$10,000 per year for any coach who coaches more than one sport with annual reporting to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee.

* Community Education Center Funding: States that funding for the Center will be used for operations and to teach industrial subjects for citizens and employers in Southwest Arkansas.

* Henderson State University (HSU) and College of the Ouachitas (COTO) Cooperative Agreement: States that in Clark county COTO shall not offer classes that HSU offers and will meet with HSU prior to offering credit-bearing technical programs, which are to be taught at HSU's Community Education Center. HSU shall offer right of first refusal to COTO for courses/programs that HSU cannot provide, to be provided in Clark County.
