I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCE

MISSION

The Physical Therapy board is a licensing and regulatory organization created to protect the public from incompetent, unprofessional and unlawful practice of physical therapy. The board is responsible for the examination and licensure of all physical therapists and physical therapists assistants. Pursuant to A.C.A. 17-93-201, the board investigates and adjudicates complaints against licensees and unlicensed individuals in violation of the law.

TOTAL BUDGET

The total appropriation for fiscal year 2015 is \$260,130.

FUNDING SOURCE

The State Board of Physical Therapy is a cash funded agency, funded from licensure and renewal fees.

IV) SPECIAL LANGUAGE:

PROFESSIONAL FEES: Special language prohibits board members from performing any investigative work that may be required by the board. The board must contract with an independent or private contractor for investigative duties, as needed. Allocates \$25K of appropriation in the professional fees line item for investigative duties.
