I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES
The Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners was created by Act
144 of 1887. Act 14 of 1955(A.C.A. 17-82-101 et seq.), known as
the Arkansas Dental Practice Act, governs Board operations. The
Board regulates the practice of dentistry, dental hygiene, and
dental assisting, by examining applicants for competency and
issuing licenses to candidates meeting the requirements of the State and the Board. The Board is composed of six practicing
dentists, one practicing dental hygienist, and two consumer
representative; one representing senior citizens. Members are
appointed by the Governor to five year terms, and officers are
elected annually.
TOTAL AUTHORIZED
The total budget for FY2015 is \$493,386.
FUNDING SOURCE
The Board is funded by cash funds that are collected by the
Board through applications for licensure, renewal of licenses,
issuance and renewal of permits, late penalties, and
disciplinary fines.
II) SIGNIFICANT CHANGE LEVEL REQUESTS
• The Operations appropriation, funded by Cash Funds,
provides a total appropriation of \$493,386 with change
level requests of (\$50,000), which includes:
1. Operating Expenses decreased by \$50,000 as the appropriation is not
required the second year of the biennium.
