I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

To provide quality vocational training to all qualified inmates allowing re-entering society with a marketable skill. Riverside Vo-Tech is part of the Arkansas Correctional School System (Act 496 of 2005) and provides vocational training to all qualified inmates incarcerated within the Arkansas Departments of Correction and Community Corrections. Programs are 1440 contact hours in length and participation is voluntary. Programs are offered at the Varner, Tucker, Wrightsville, Brickeys, Grimes, and Malvern Units, the Newport Unit for female offenders and at Community Corrections locations in Little Rock, Pine Bluff and Osceola.

TOTAL BUDGET

The total appropriation is approximately \$2.3 million.

Funding is General Revenue.
