

**DFA - OFFICE OF CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT (634)

**I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES**

**MISSION**

The Office of Child Support Enforcement is responsible for locating absent parents, establishing paternity, establishing orders for support, collecting and disbursing support, and enforcing payment of support.

**TOTAL APPROPRIATION**

The total appropriation of the Office of Child Support Enforcement for FY2015 is \$65,796,463.

**FUNDING SOURCE**

The appropriations for this agency consist of 66% federal reimbursement, and a combination of general revenue, fees collected, federal incentive payments and state share of Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) collections equaling 34%.

**II) APPROPRIATIONS / CHANGES**

**1. State operations** appropriation is \$65,796,463 for FY2015, with no significant changes from 2014.

**III) POSITIONS**

**IV) SPECIAL LANGUAGE**
