I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCE

MISSION

The Commission is responsible for establishing minimum standards for the selection and training of law enforcement officers in Arkansas. The Commission provides basic training for new officers and specialized training for certified police officers at the ALETA training academy near East Camden and in Springdale, while providing field training classes as requested across the state.

TOTAL BUDGET

The total appropriation for fiscal year 2015 is \$4,604,011.

FUNDING SOURCE

The Commission operates from four appropriations and is funded primarily from general revenues from the miscellaneous agencies fund account, cash funds generated from fees collected for the use of the Training Academy's facilities and for meals purchased by the Fire Training Academy for students enrolled in training.
