I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCE

MISSION

The State Crime Laboratory provides forensic and scientific laboratory services, written analysis of evidence and corroborative testimony for all the state's law enforcement and criminal justice community to assist in the apprehension and conviction of individuals involved in criminal cases.

TOTAL BUDGET

The total appropriation for fiscal year 2015 is \$15,630,003.

SOURCE OF FUNDING

The State Crime Lab is funded from general revenue through the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund, a portion of uniform filing fees collected in circuit court (A.C.A 16-10-313) and through a fund transfer from the Administration of Justice Fund. Additional revenue sources include federal grants from the US Dept. of Justice and special revenues generated from the forfeitures of funds and property derived through court proceedings and a mandatory fine required by convicted persons required to submit to a DNA sample.

Crime Lab receives twenty percent (20%) of all forfeitures over the first \$20,000 of forfeitures per county, per year.

II) SIGNIFICANT CHANGES:

Crime Lab Federal: appropriation change level requests totaling \$1,291,930 provide for the following:

- Regular Salaries and Personal Services Matching increases of \$191,930 for the restoration of three Forensic Scientists and one Forensic Technician.
- Operating Expense increase of \$100,000 for health and laboratory supplies.
- Capital Outlay \$1,000,000 for lab equipment.

Crime Lab Operations:

- Appropriation and general revenue increases totaling \$103,000 each year include Professional Fees of \$78K for a transport service and \$25K for sales tax on vehicles and purchase of a nitrogen generator.

Capital outlay appropriation of \$250K for equipment
