TO REQUIRE A SCHOOL DISTRICT SUBJECT TO A DESEGREGATION ORDER TO NOTIFY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND TO PROVIDE A COPY OF THE DESEGREGATION ORDER; TO AMEND THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CHOICE ACT OF 2013; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.
<u>SB204</u>	J. English	TO CREATE THE TRANSPARENCY IN PRIVATE ATTORNEY CONTRACTS ACT; AND TO REGULATE THE ATTORNEY GENERAL'S PROCUREMENT OF CERTAIN CONTRACTS WITH PRIVATE ATTORNEYS.
<u>SB221</u>	Files	AUTHORIZING COUNTIES TO PURCHASE EXCESS, SURPLUS, OR UNUSED BRIDGE STEEL OR MATERIALS FROM THE GENERAL CONTRACTOR OF CERTAIN PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS.
<u>SB228</u>	Irvin	TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE ORGANIZATIONAL PROCEDURES OF CITY COUNCILS.
<u>SB230</u>	Teague	AN ACT TO REQUIRE WINERIES TO COLLECT LOCAL TAXES ON DIRECT SHIPMENTS OF WINE.

<u>HB1245</u>	Shepherd Burnett	TO ENACT THE UNIFORM PARTITION OF HEIRS PROPERTY ACT; AND TO MAKE RELATED TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.
