I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The Board was created to regulate the practice of Psychology. The Board's major functions are approving the credentials of applicants, administering both written and oral examinations and the investigation of possible ethical violations or allegations of incompetent practice. The Board also is charged with implementing continuing education requirements.

TOTAL APPROPRIATION

The agency's total appropriation is \$187,563 for FY2016.

FUNDING SOURCE

The agency is cash funded by fees collected from licenses and examinations.

The appropriation provides for one position reclassification of C115 Director of Psychology Board to C117 APB Administrative Director, resulting in an increase of operating expenses of \$691.
