Senator Gregory B. Standridge represents Senate District 16, which is comprised of Newton and Pope Counties and parts of Boone, Carroll and Van Buren Counties. Elected in a special election in 2015, he is co-chairman of the Rural Fire Departments Study Committee. During the 90th General Assembly, he is a member of Senate Transportation, Technology and Legislative Affairs; Senate City, County and Local Affairs; Senate Children and Youth; Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission Oversight; Intermodal Transportation and Commerce Task Force; Economic and Tax Policy and Boys State.

Regionally and nationally, Senator Standridge works with legislators across the United States as a member of the Southern Legislative Conference (SLC), the National Conference of State Legislatures (NCSL), the Council of State Governments (CSG) and the American Legislative Exchange Council (ALEC).
