## Legislative Impact Statement

**Bill: HB1483**

**Bill Subtitle: TO MAKE LEGISLATIVE CORRECTIONS TO AND REPEAL OBSOLETE LAWS CONTAINED IN TITLE 27 OF THE ARKANSAS CODE.**

### **Basic Change :**

**Sponsors: Representative Shepherd and Senator Rapert**

HB1483 makes technical corrections to as well as repeals obsolete laws contained in Title 27 of the Arkansas Code. Notably, references to the "Commissioner to Office of Motor Vehicles" is replaced with the appropriate title of "Director of the Arkansas Department of Finance and Administration".

### **Legal Analysis :**

HB1483 makes technical, not substantive changes to Arkansas law. Relevant definitions are combined under the same code sections and repealed from throughout the code. Technical corrections are made updating the outdated title of "Commissioner of Motor Vehicles" to the "Director of Finance and Administration;" however, Arkansas Code §§ 27-14-405 and 27-14-407 are not corrected to make this change. It may be recommended that the bill be amended to also make this change so that all obsolete references in the Arkansas Code to "Commissioner of Motor Vehicle" are removed.
