I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

Phillips Community College of the University of Arkansas is located in Helena, Arkansas is a two year institution of higher education. The institution also has off-campus satellite programs in Stuttgart and DeWitt. The institution's website states that through its mission it is "committed to individual, organizational and community development by: providing accessible, affordable education, training and public services; providing high quality educational opportunities; and supporting the economic growth of Eastern Arkansas."

TOTAL APPROPRIATION

The total appropriation for FY2018 is \$56,016,979.

FUNDING SOURCES

The budget is funded from General Revenue, Educational Excellence Trust Funds, Work Force 2000 funds, and Cash Funds from tuition, fees and Federal funds.

II) CHANGE LEVEL REQUESTS

The recommended appropriation levels for State Operations Appropriations are based on the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board's recommendation which is based on providing institutions 75% of the funding determined necessary under the current funding formula for institutions of higher education.

<u>State Operations - Helena (Appropriation 308)</u> - This provides a total appropriation of \$7,220,769 for FY2018 and is funded by General Revenue and the Educational Excellence Trust Fund. The decrease of \$6,297 is due to changes in the following line item:

Operating Expenses - a decrease of \$6,297 for FY2018.

State Operations - DeWitt (Appropriation 1BW) - This provides a total appropriation of \$1,327,257 for FY2018 and is funded by General Revenue and Special Revenues from Work Force 2000 funds. The net increase of \$4,226 from the 2017 Budgeted Level are due to changes in the following line items:

Regular Salaries - a decrease of \$11,514.

Operating Expenses - an increase of \$15,740.

State Operations - Stuttgart (Appropriation 413) - This provides a total appropriation of \$1,838,953 for FY2018 and is funded by General Revenue. The increase of \$7,510 from the 2017 Budgeted Level is due to changes in the following line item:

Operating Expenses - an increase of \$7,510.

<u>Cash Operations - Helena (Appropriation A73)</u> - This appropriation is funded by tuition, fees, investment income, and cash funds. There is no change in total appropriation, but there are changes

in the following line items:

Conference Fees and Travel - an increase of \$100,000.

Capital Outlay - a decrease of \$100,000.

<u>Cash Operations (Dewitt and Stuttgart Campuses)</u> - No Change Level Requests.
