I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES:

MISSION

This agency is responsible for determining disability for the Social Security Administration and for conducting administrative appeals for the Federal government.

TOTAL APPROPRIATION

The total appropriation for FY2018 is \$55,823,959.

FUNDING SOURCE

Federally funded (100%) by the Social Security Administration.

II) CHANGE LEVEL REQUESTS:

OPERATIONS (APPROPRIATION 2QQ)

This appropriation provides for the operations of the Administration. The total appropriation is \$55,823,959 for FY2018, is funded solely with federal revenue and includes the following changes:

Regular Salaries and Personal Services Matching - Increase of \$1,783,196 in FY2018 for the restoration of sixteen (16) Adjudicative Grade C113 positions, six (6) Medical Consultant N916 positions and one (1) Medical Specialist N919 position to allow the agency to meet workload goals assigned by the federal SSA Office.

Overtime and related Personal Services Matching - Increase of \$500,000 to allow the agency to meet workload goals assigned by the federal SSA Office.

Capital Outlay - Increase of \$100,000 for desks, cubicles and other office equipment for one of the adjudicative units.
