DHS-DIRECTOR'S OFFICE (716) COMBINED ADMINISTRATIVE FUNCTIONS FISCAL YEAR 2018

As Enacted by Acts 903 and 913 of 2017

I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The Department is requesting the creation of a new structure for the administrative components of the agency consisting of the following eight sections: Director's Office, Office of Finance, Office of Procurement, Office of Systems and Technology, Office of Human Resources, Office of Chief Counsel, Office of Legislative & Intergovernmental Affairs and Office of Communications and Community Engagement. This reorganization aims to consolidated various required administrative functions into a centralized location to better coordinate efforts across the agency.

TOTAL APPROPRIATION

The total appropriations recommended are \$77,954,545 with increases of \$19,091,658.

FUNDING SOURCES

The budget is funded by federal funds, general revenue, various program support, reimbursements and cash.

II) CHANGE LEVEL REQUESTS

<u>Operations</u> **CHANGES** Combines all the previously separated Administrative Paying appropriations into a single section)

The recommendation for this appropriation, funded from General Revenue, Federal Funds and other sources, is for \$62,137,940 with increases of \$17,588,510 including the following changes to support the agency's administrative reorganization:

Regular Salaries increases of \$10,904,358 and Personal Services Matching increases of \$3,835,249.

Extra Help increases of \$155,860.

Operating Expenses increases of \$1,888,613.

Conference and Travel increases of \$137,930.

Professional Fees increases of \$500,000.

Capital Outlay increases of \$165,000.

Data Processing Services increase of \$1,500.

Various Building Construction

The recommendation for this appropriation, funded from Federal reimbursement, general revenues transferred from other Divisions and other funds, is for \$12,232,687 with an increase of

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\$1,503,148 to provide for ongoing maintenance/construction.

III) ADDITIONAL POSITIONS - **CHANGES** Combines all the previously separated regular salaries sections into a single section (Total FY2017 Authorized Positions: 530)

Total Positions for FY2018: 678

Total Base Level Positions: 466

Increase (Decrease): 212 - Elimination of (12) positions and the restoration/transfer of 224 positions to support the agency's administrative reorganization.

Extra Help Positions FY2018: 30 (Base Level Extra Help: 30)

IV) SPECIAL LANGUAGE

- **PURCHASE OF EVIDENCE:** The Chief Counsel can transfer up to \$12,000 to a bank account to be used to purchase evidence in the course of fraud investigations within the Food Stamp program.
- HUMAN SERVICES RENOVATION FUND: Department may use for constructing, acquiring, and renovating facilities, limits the amount of general revenue that may be transferred to the fund to \$5 million per year and for unanticipated projects only, requires that transfers to the fund must receive prior approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer, the Governor, and the Legislative Council/Joint Budget Committee. Non-severability language is added to this section so that if a court rules the approval requirement is unconstitutional, the entire section is void.
- **REVISED LANGUAGE** TRANSFER AUTHORITY: Establishes guidelines for transfers of appropriation, funds, and positions within the Department. Deletes the language in subsection (c)regarding transfers made for the Division of Youth Services Housing and Separation Provisions and adds similar language into the Department of Human Services Division of Youth Services bill (Act 837). It places a limitation of two four transfer requests per fiscal year and a maximum transfer limit of 5% of appropriation, funding, and positions. It also enumerates 7 purposes for which transfers may be made. No single Division can request reallocation for more than one purpose.
- NURSING/DIRECT CARE EDUCATION STIPEND PROGRAM: Provides for a Nursing /Direct Care Education Stipend Program for DHS to be paid with State and Federal funds. The stipend is for Registered or Licensed Practical Nurses, Certified Nursing Assistants, Residential Care Assistants/ Technicians/

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- Supervisors, and Behavioral Health Aide students and is \$5,000 per person per year. Each division will determine the number of student stipends available.
- NURSING/DIRECT CARE RECRUITMENT/RETENTION BONUSES: Allows for recruitment and retention bonuses for DHS employees to be paid with State and Federal funds from each respective division. Bonuses cannot exceed \$4,000 for Registered Nurses; \$2,000 for Licenses Practical Nurses; and \$1,000 for Certified Nursing Assistants, Residential Care Assistants/Technicians/Supervisors, and Behavioral Health Aides.
- ** LANGUAGE TO BE DELETED** FUND TRANSFER PROVISION HEALTH CARE INDEPENDENCE PROGRAM TRUST FUND: The entire
 amount received and retained in the Medicaid Trust Fund
 from the Pulaski Co. Circuit Court Case CV2007-15345 shall
 be transferred from the Medicaid Trust Fund to the Health
 Care Independence Program Trust Fund. Does not appear in
 bill.

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
