I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

Arkansas Tech University is dedicated to student success, access, and excellence as a responsive campus community providing opportunities for progressive intellectual development and civic engagement. Embracing and expanding upon its technological traditions, Tech inspires and empowers members of the community to achieve their goals while striving for the betterment of Arkansas, the nation, and the world. The Institution is located in Russellville, Arkansas and is a four year institution of higher education.

TOTAL APPROPRIATION

The total appropriation is approximately \$223.2 million for FY2019.

FUNDING SOURCES

The appropriation is funded from approximately 15% General Revenue, 1% Educational Excellence Trust and Workforce 2000 Funds, with the remainder as cash funds from tuition/fees & sales, and federal funds.

II) CHANGE LEVEL REQUESTS

State Operations (Appropriation 567) - This appropriation is funded from general revenue, Educational Excellence Trust funds, and Workforce 2000 funds. The recommended appropriation levels are based on the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board's recommendation which is based on the current funding formula for institutions of higher education. The total appropriation is approximately \$35.9 million in FY2019 with the following changes against authorized:

Regular Salaries - Decrease of approximately (\$7.7 million).

Extra Help - Decrease of approximately (\$1.8 million).

Personal Services Match. - Decrease of approximately (\$1.8 million).

Operating Expenses - Decrease of approximately (\$2.4 million).

Conference Fees & Travel - Decrease of (\$29,625).

III) ADDITIONAL POSITIONS

IV) SPECIAL LANGUAGE

Food Service: Authorizes the University to operate the food service with contingency positions if the current contract is cancelled after obtaining approval of the Dept. of Higher Education and the Chief Fiscal Officer with prior Legislative Council review. (contingency positions not requested)

Special Allowances: Authorizes special allowances of up to \$10,000 per year for any coach who coaches more than one sport and requires annual reporting to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee if utilized.

Ark. Tech. Inst.: The University shall administer the direction of Arkansas Tech Institute (ATI), with priorities of economic, technology, and cyber-park development, and shall make annual reports concerning funding, programs, and services offered by ATI to the Legislative Council.
