I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The State Board of Optometry gives examinations to doctors who wish to practice optometry in Arkansas; approves courses, seminars and conferences to assure qualifications for license renewal requirements are met; issues yearly renewals; keeps individual files and records of each registered Optometrist in the State, and investigates consumer complaints. Act 176 of 1997 amended the Arkansas Code giving the Board authority to promulgate the rules and regulations governing the prescribing of oral medications and controlled substances by Optometrists.

TOTAL APPROPRIATION

The total appropriation for the State Board of Optometry for FY2019 is \$185,935.

FUNDING SOURCE

The appropriations for the Board are funded with cash funds received from licenses and fees.
