# DHS-DIRECTOR'S OFFICE (716) FISCAL YEAR 2019 As Enacted by Act 253 of 2018

### I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

### MISSION

This division houses the administrative components of the agency consisting of the following eight sections: Director's Office, Office of Finance, Office of Procurement, Office of Systems and Technology, Office of Human Resources, Office of Chief Counsel, Office of Legislative & Intergovernmental Affairs and Office of Communications and Community Engagement. This administrative reorganization was directed as part of Act 913 of 2017.

#### TOTAL APPROPRIATION

The total appropriations are \$77,378,986 in FY2019 with a total decrease of (\$575,559).

#### FUNDING SOURCES

The budget is funded by federal funds, general revenue, various program support, reimbursements and cash.

#### II) CHANGE LEVEL REQUESTS

## Operations

The recommendation for this appropriation, funded from General Revenue, Federal Funds and other sources, is for \$62,171,865 with increases of \$33,925 including the following changes:

Regular Salaries increases of \$17,500 and Personal Services Matching increases of \$4,973.

Operating Expenses increase of \$11,452.

#### Various Building Construction

The recommendation for this appropriation, funded from Federal reimbursement, general revenues transferred from other Divisions and other funds, is for \$11,623,203, a decrease of (\$609,484).

#### IV) SPECIAL LANGUAGE

• PURCHASE OF EVIDENCE: The Chief Counsel can transfer up to

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- \$12,000 to a bank account to be used to purchase evidence in the course of fraud investigations within the Food Stamp program.
- HUMAN SERVICES RENOVATION FUND: Department may use for constructing, acquiring, and renovating facilities, limits the amount of general revenue that may be transferred to the fund to \$5 million per year and for unanticipated projects only, requires that transfers to the fund must receive prior approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer, the Governor, and the Legislative Council/Joint Budget Committee. Non-severability language is added to this section so that if a court rules the approval requirement is unconstitutional, the entire section is void.
- TRANSFER AUTHORITY: Establishes guidelines for transfers of appropriation, funds, and positions within the Department. It places a limitation of four transfer requests per fiscal year and a maximum transfer limit of 5% of appropriation, funding, and positions. It also enumerates 7 purposes for which transfers may be made. No single Division can request reallocation for more than one purpose.
- NURSING/DIRECT CARE EDUCATION STIPEND PROGRAM: Provides for a Nursing /Direct Care Education Stipend Program for DHS to be paid with State and Federal funds. The stipend is for Registered or Licensed Practical Nurses, Certified Nursing Assistants, Residential Care Assistants/ Technicians/ Supervisors, and Behavioral Health Aide students and is \$5,000 per person per year. Each division will determine the number of student stipends available.
- NURSING/DIRECT CARE RECRUITMENT/RETENTION BONUSES: Allows for recruitment and retention bonuses for DHS employees to be paid with State and Federal funds from each respective division. Bonuses cannot exceed \$4,000 for Registered Nurses; \$2,000 for Licenses Practical Nurses; and \$1,000 for Certified Nursing Assistants, Residential Care Assistants/Technicians/Supervisors, and Behavioral Health Aides.
