Legislative Impact Statement

Bill: HB1012

Bill Subtitle: TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF A PURPLE HEART RECIPIENT SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE TO A SURVIVING SPOUSE.

Basic Change :

Sponsor: Rep. Ladyman

HB1012 amends § 27-24-208 to add a new subsection “(c)” to permit the surviving spouse of a deceased person who would have been entitled to receive a Purple Heart Recipient special license plate to apply for and be issued a Purple Heart Recipient plate. The surviving spouse must: (1) provide proof of the deceased person’s eligibility for the Purple Heart plate; and (2) pay the fee required by § 27-24-206(a)(2), which is not to be greater than \$1.00.

Revenue Impact :

Taxpayer Impact :

The surviving spouse of a person that was eligible to be issued a Purple Heart Recipient plate will be eligible to be issued a Purple Heart Recipient plate upon presentation of proof eligibility of the deceased person and payment of the fee.

Resources Required :

No additional resources will be required.

Time Required :

Adequate time is provided.

Procedural Changes :

None.

Other Comments :

Current law permits a surviving spouse to be reissued a free Purple Heart Recipient plate of a deceased person to whom a plate was previously issued.
