SPECIAL LANGUAGE REVISIONS

- <u>Juvenile Transportation</u> language is deleted as the related appropriation line item was transferred out of DFA – Disbursing Officer to a different agency. This language noted that funds for Transportation of Juveniles line item are intended for grants/reimbursements to cities and counties to transport juveniles to approved facilities.
- <u>Allocation Restrictions</u> language is revised to reflect the increased appropriation provided to Administration of Justice Fund from an amendment; it increases the allocations for the Court Reporter Fund (\$719,541) and the Trial Court Administrator Fund (\$551,492), with the Administration of Justice Allocation fund total equaling the new \$41,191,628 from the appropriation section.

NEW LANGUAGE <u>TRANSFER PROCEDURES – APPROPRIATION – C.A.R.E.S.</u> – New language outlines the procedures necessary to transfer appropriation from the C.A.R.E.S. appropriation to other agencies, including legislative review by ALC or JBC

NEW LANGUAGE <u>PANDEMIC UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION</u> <u>PROGRAM</u> – New language states that should the program be administered by a department other than DFA, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer any remaining appropriation and fund balances to that Department.
