Legislative Impact Statement

Bill: HB1161

Bill Subtitle: TO AUTHORIZE A MICROBREWERY-RESTAURANT PRIVATE CLUB TO SELL BEVERAGES MANUFACTURED BY THE PRIVATE CLUB DIRECTLY TO OTHER PERMIT HOLDERS; AND TO AMEND PORTIONS OF THE LAW RESULTING FROM INITIATED ACT 1 OF 1942.

Basic Change :

Sponsor: Rep. Maddox

HB1161 would allow a microbrewery-restaurant private club to sell certain alcoholic beverages to other alcoholic beverage permit holders. Currently, microbrewery-restaurant private clubs may sell certain alcoholic beverages that they manufacture only to permitted wholesalers.

This bill would become effective 90 days after sine die adjournment.

Revenue Impact :

Arkansas beer tax is levied at the wholesale level and reported and remitted to the Department of Finance and Administration (DFA) on the 15th of each month. HB1161 would have no known wholesale level revenue impact.

Taxpayer Impact :

A microbrewery-restaurant private club would be authorized to sell certain alcoholic beverages to other alcoholic beverage permit holders.
