#### **ADDITIONAL COMMENTS**

√ Arkansas Department of Education - Division of Higher Education notes that students cannot receive both the Academic Challenge and the Workforce Challenge scholarship. This may result in the fiscal impact being on the low end, as some students eligible for both scholarships will choose to accept the Academic Challenge and forego the Workforce Challenge.
