Sponsor: Sen. A. Clark

SB261 amends § 27-14-725 to require vehicle identification number (VIN) verification prior to the sale of a three-wheeled, four-wheeled, or six-wheeled all-terrain vehicle by any person engaged in the sale of those vehicles. Additionally, the bill creates a new section, § 27-20-209, to require the same verification.

Taxpayer Impact:

Any person engaged in the business of selling three-wheeled, four-wheeled or six-wheeled all-terrain vehicles will be required to have a VIN verification done prior to any sale.
