## Legislative Impact Statement

**Bill: SB428**

**Bill Subtitle: TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO TITLE 9 OF THE ARKANSAS CODE CONCERNING FAMILY LAW.**

### **Basic Change :**

**Sponsors: Sen. Ballinger and Rep. Gazaway**

SB428 clarifies and makes technical corrections to portions of Title 9 of the Arkansas Code concerning family law including nondisclosure of certain information obtained during an adoption proceeding by members of the General Assembly and adult maltreatment custody and protective services records obtained by federal and state representatives and senators; requirements for when and how a parent or guardian must consent to marriage for a person 17 years of age; and, repealing provisions for the State Commission on Child Support, which itself was previously repealed.

### **Legal Analysis :**

SB428 repeals §§ 9-14-402 and -403 concerning provisions for the State Commission on Child Support. The State Commission on Child Support was previously repealed by Acts 1999, Nos. 1508 and 1514. With the statute creating the State Commission on Child Support having been repealed, the statutes remaining in Subchapter 4 of Title 9 are no longer required. This will result in no substantive changes in the law.
