√ This is caused by the increase in Foundation Funding of \$64 per student multiplied by an estimated ADM of 487,621. Based on a decline in average daily membership during the previous school year, the Department will be able to absorb the cost for FY23.

### **ADDITIONAL COMMENTS**

√ In the future changes to the matrix for teacher insurance line items will result in a need of additional revenue.
