#### SPECIAL LANGUAGE REVISIONS

<u>Educator Compensation Reform Program</u> - Revised to remove a sentence of language providing for a one-time transfer of \$60 Million from Educational Adequacy Fund to the Public School Fund. This transfer has occurred and the language is no longer necessary.

<u>NEW Language - Code Amendment</u> - Added to provide for a Code Amendment to Arkansas Code 6-51-303 to allow school districts to use tax revenues to provide operations costs for Vocational Ed Centers.
